



CAPSLink 4.2.0 Release Notes

Security - Password Functionality

- CAPSLink will now prevent a user from recycling their last six passwords.
- Users who have an email address tied to their CAPSLink account (through MFA or User Settings) will receive an email link for resetting their password when utilizing the Forgot Password workflow.

User Access Report

- A User Audit Report is now available in both 503A and 503B Report menus. The report will contain date and time of last user access, as well as order/patient modification events.

Patient Name Length

- When the length of a Patient's Name (first and last) exceeds 32 characters a warning will display to the user (**see below**). When names are longer than 32 characters the entire name may not be visible on the order label.

Alphabetical sorting

- The Patient List screen will now sort alphabetically whether the first character of the last name is upper or lower case.
- The Release to CAPS by Area report was updated to sort alphabetically by area.

Auto Release Order Status

- After Auto Release orders are validated, the order status will now correctly display as "Released to CAPS" and the "Send to CAPS" button will be disabled on the order entry screen.

Chloride/Acetate

- When Chloride/Acetate values are changed from mEQ to %, the values will now adjust to total 100%.

Order Calculators

- "ml" was changed to "mL" in all instances on the Order Volume/Kg and Advanced 24hr Volume/Kg calculators.

503B Order Tracking

- UPS tracking notifications via email are now available for 503B orders. To receive notifications the user must select the UPS shipment tracking option in user settings. (*see checkbox below*).
