



CAPSLink 3.3.0 Release Notes

Security

- New passwords must be 16 to 30 characters in length and include 3 of the following: one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter, a number, a symbol. When a new password is created it will need to meet this criteria. This includes new user passwords, reset passwords, and expired passwords.
- Users will no longer be able to bypass the temporary password change prompts, which allowed the user to access CAPSLink without completing the password change process.

Patient List

- The “Active” radio button will now be selected by default when accessing the Patient List.

Order Validation

- All instances of the text “errors” have been replaced with “alerts”.
- Fixes have been made to the APEX overfill process, eliminating warnings which prevented the user from validating the order.

Labels/Reports

- Customer Service QA Quarterly reports are now available for each 503B CAPS pharmacy. Accessed under 503B > QA Reports
- Fixed the issue that required the user to clear the browser cache on every login by pressing Ctrl-F5 to see the Spending Reports in the main screen navigation. This may still be required on a user’s first access to the reports but on subsequent logins the reports should appear in the navigation without the need to clear the cache.

Drug Delivery (503B)

- Removing the “Reports” permission from a user now prevents the user from accessing 503A and 503B reports.
- The Order Confirmation window and corresponding printed report will now display the “Order Number” instead of the “Packing List number”.
